Paperless life helps in many ways. When documents have been printed out, scanning them into the computer system can save money. A document is averagely copied 11 to 19 times throughout its lifetime. It increases the cost of each printed page. On the contrary, if you can electronically store, access, share and track files, you will greatly reduce the time spent on filing, searching for, copying, and/or mailing physical documents.

Imagine that a company produces just 50 important documents each day for filing. If it takes five minutes to file each document, you are paying for 250 minutes of filing each day, or roughly four hours. If you are paying your staff \$ 15 an hour, you are looking at \$ 60 a day, or \$ 15,000 each year in filing costs alone. Additionally, being able to access and share these documents electronically improves productivity and efficiency.

If we go paperless, office space used for paper storage will be freed up, and more money will be saved. A regular four-drawer file cabinet takes about 15 square feet of space. If you are paying \$ 40 per square foot for your company space, one cabinet is costing you \$ 600 a month.
